RESOLUTION NO 62-2000

**RESOLUTION DECLARING MALUMPATI HEALTH SPRING TOURIST
RESORT AS MUNICIPAL PARK**

WHEREAS, Malumpati Health Spring and Tourist Resort was identified as main ecotourism site of the municipality of Pandan, Antique;

WHEREAS, there is a need to protect the Malumpati Health Spring and Tourist Resort and its watershed area from environmental destruction and degradation;

WHEREAS, several Sangguniang Bayan Resolution have been passed by previous administration, requesting the national Government thru the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and Provincial Government thru CENRO, to declare Malumpati Health Spring and Tourist Resort as Municipal Park, but was not acted upon;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA. 7160) now empower the Local Sangguniang Bayan to declare certain portion in there area as reserve sanctuary and wildlife park;

WHEREAS, this declaration will ultimately make the Malumpati Health Spring and Tourist Resort as part of NORTHWEST PANAY FOREST PROTECTED AREA, hence, an assurance of an environmental protection;

WHEREAS, this undertaking will deputize the barangay government particularly its “tanods” and the Bantey Gubat Volunteers in the enforcement of environmental protection related Municipal Ordinances and will be beneficial to the protection and preservation of Malumpati health Spring and Tourist Resort.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. **Renato D. Tugon, M.D.**, duly seconded by Hon. Edesio G. Pechon, Hon. Mildred R. Camero and Hon. Emmanuel V. Samulde, this Sanggunian, in a regular session assembled, resolved, as it hereby resolves to declare, as it is hereby declared, the Malumpati Health Spring and Tourist Resort as Municipal Park.
